Reverse Osmosis (RO) Plant was installed and commissioned (See Picture 2) at PP (AP). This is used for recycling of cooling tower blow down (about 1,000 kl/day), recovering 820 kl/day of water for using back in the process. This will help reduce water consumption from the existing level of 2.92 to 2.65 l/kWh.
